

Endless Pearl Bracelet - making elastic cord jewelry



Tools: scissors & G-S Hypo cement

Materials to make a 7.5" bracelet:

- 72 - 81 x (6 - 7mm) fresh water pearls in 2 - 3 colors
- 9 x roundels (5mm) with Swarovski crystals (silver or gold)
- 3 x 3 - hole separator bar (silver or gold)
- 9 x 3mm round beads (sterling silver or gold-filled)
- 3 x 1 ft Power Pro® elastic cord (0.5 mm)

Estimated time: 60 minutes

Estimated cost: \$45 - \$60



1. For each strand, string 8 - 9 pearls, 1 round bead, 1 roundel. Repeat with 2 other strands, then, string separator bars on either side of the 3 strands. This completes one section of the bracelet



2. Continue with the other two sections, careful to end elastic at the roundels. Tie a square knot following by a surgical knot (go around string twice on the 2nd step of square knot) , pull elastic cord to tighten the knots, and dap the cement to set the knots. Cut off the tails after 5 minutes.



Tips for making jewelry with elastic cords:

Always use the highest quality elastic cord you can afford. That will prolong the life of your jewelry.

If possible, tie the knots at the beads with larger holes so the knots can be hidden nicely.
