

# Stack-up Pendant Necklace



**Tools:** Chain nose pliers

**Materials:**

- 2 - 3 rectangle fresh water pearls with double holes
- 6 - 8 x Swarovski® Bicone beads (4 mm)
- 2 x 9.5" - 10" sterling silver beading chain (0.65 mm)
- 4 x sterling silver crimp beads (1 x 1 mm)
- 2 x sterling silver end caps for beading chain
- 2 x sterling silver jump rings (4 mm heavy)
- 1 x sterling silver clasp

Estimated time: 30 - 45 minutes

Estimated cost: \$22- \$24



1. String 1x crimp bead to one end of a beading chain. Flatten the crimp bead to secure. Repeat the process for the other beading chain. The crimp beads serve as stoppers for the pendant.



2. String crystals and pearls alternatively as shown on the photo to make the pendant stack. Either 2-pearl stack or 3-pearl stack will work fine. Finish the pendant stack with crystals. String 1 x crimp bead on each of the beading chain on top of the last crystal. Flatten the crimp beads to secure.



3. String 1x 4 mm crystal, 1x Helix crystal, 1x 4 mm crystal and 1x crimp bead next to the crimp bead from Step 2. Crimp the last crimp bead in place. Repeat Step 2 & 3 for the other side.
